
New Regulations Effective July 21, 2008

The Social Security Administration has been listening, learning, and responding, making changes to their programs and how they do business to more effectively provide opportunities for people with disabilities who want to work.

Social Security's **NEW** Ticket to Work Program provides Employment Networks and State VR agencies with following:

- Greater opportunities to receive Ticket revenue with a new payment structure,
- Ability to expand/diversify business connections with new rules on collaboration between ENs and VRs, and
- Access to more beneficiaries with expanded Ticket eligibility criteria and increased outreach.
